special service will include The Lord's Supper. We have three new Deacons: David Myers is already ordained and Jason Moss and Nathaniel Orr will be ordained this morning.



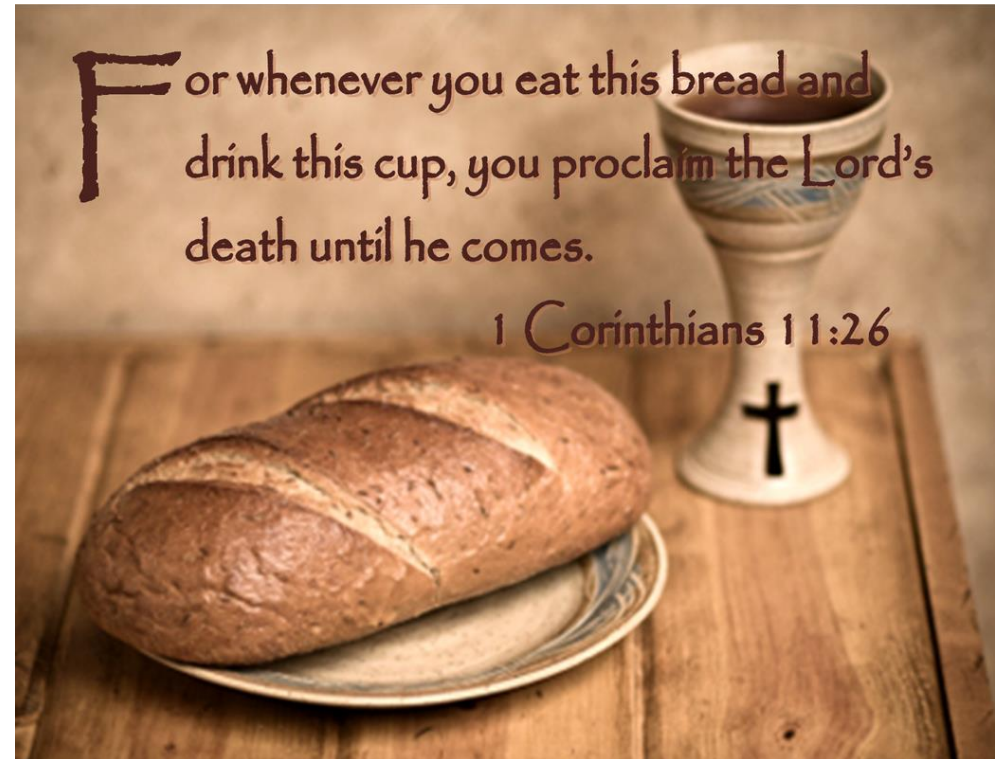
CHURCH THANKSGIVING DINNER
