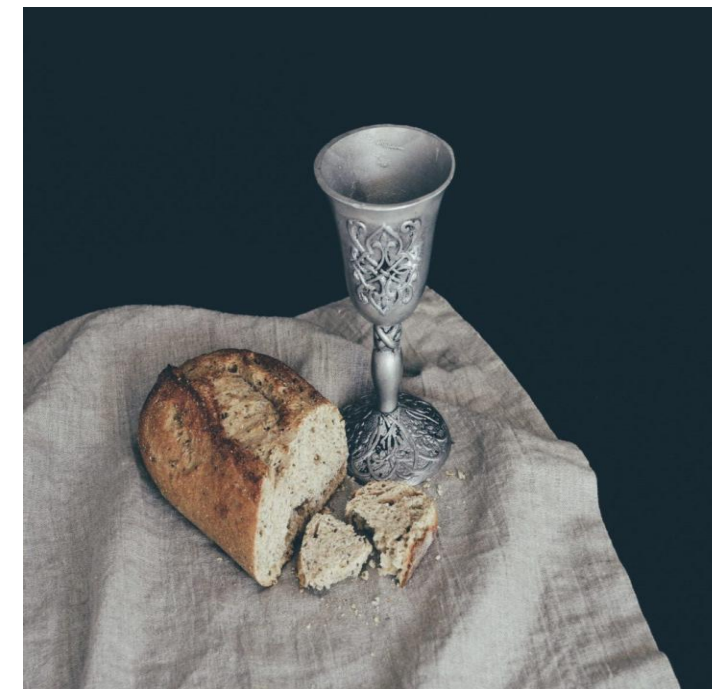
Daylight Savings Time, do not forget to move your clocks forward!
